SESSION 2009, SESSION LAW 2009-406, SENATE BILL 831 *S831-v-6*

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: the "Permit Extension Act of 2009."

SL 2009-406 – AN ACT TO EXTEND CERTAIN GOVERNMENT APPROVALS AFFECTING THE DEVELOPMENT OF REAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE STATE

Session Law 2009-406 extends coverage of certain Division of Environmental Health (DEH) permits and approvals that are current and valid at any point between January 1, 2008 and December 31, 2010 under Article 11 of Chapter 130A of the General Statutes. These extensions apply to permitted facilities regardless of construction status, and apply to permits issued to both government and non-government entities. This would include the following onsite wastewater permits and approvals issued by DEH:

- Improvement Permit (Article 11, Chapter 130A of the General Statutes)
- Construction Authorization (Article 11, Chapter 130A of the General Statutes)
- Operation Permit for Type V and Type VI System (Article 11, Chapter 130A of the General Statutes)

The Act suspends the permit or approval clock during the period January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2010.

Permits and approvals issued prior to January 1, 2008 and valid between January 1, 2008 and December 31, 2010, have been extended for three years (for example, a permit effective from May 5, 2005 until April 30, 2010, is extended until April 30, 2013).

New permits and approvals issued between and including January 1, 2008 and December 31, 2010 will have an expiration date that is extended for the amount of time the permit is active between January 1, 2008 and December 31, 2010. This means any permit issued on January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2010 will become valid on the date it is issued and will expire on December 31, 2015.
