



The National Association of REALTORS® has required that all REALTORS® must complete an approved Code of Ethics training every four years. The new quadrennial period began **January 1, 2009**, and ends **December 31, 2012**. Failure to fulfill this **requirement by December 31, 2012, will result in automatic suspension of membership and MLS services! To reinstate, you will have to complete the course and pay a \$50 reinstatement fee.**

You can view the Continuing Education courses you have taken with BCAR by logging onto Internet Member Services, under Your Education History look at Personal Education Tracking. You may also visit the commission's website [CLICK HERE](#).

If your records indicate you have taken the Code of Ethics class since January 1, 2009 **you can relax** until it's time to take the class again.

If your records indicate you **have not** taken the Code of Ethics class since January 1, 2009 and you do not remember that you have taken the Code of Ethics class with another CE sponsor, you may visit the commission's website [CLICK HERE](#). If your records with the commission indicate you have taken the ethics class with another CE sponsor, you **MUST** contact the sponsor **directly** and **obtain the completion certificate and fax to 910-754-6291, attention Dawn to ensure that our records reflect accordingly.**
