

Internet Explorer 7 and MLS Slowness

Are you experiencing MLS slowness after installing Internet Explorer 7?

The IE7 Phishing Filter may cause slowness on some sites, even if you chose the "Turn off automatic Phishing Filter" option ([learn more about this issue and how you can help report the problem to Microsoft®](#)). There are two ways you can restore MLS speed:

Option 1: Disable the Phishing Filter for your trusted sites

1. From a new Internet Explorer (IE) window, click **Tools > Phishing Filter > Phishing Filter Settings**.
2. Scroll down to the **Phishing Filter** setting, and verify that you have selected either **Turn off automatic website checking** or **Turn on automatic website checking**, as desired. Be sure to click **Apply** if you make a change. (For more information about the Phishing Filter, see Microsoft's documentation.)
3. While still in the **Internet Options** window, click the **Security** tab.
4. Click the **Trusted sites** icon (large green check mark). Then, click the **Sites** button.
5. Verify that **http://*.rapmls.com** is in your list of trusted sites. If it is not, enter **http://*.rapmls.com** into the field at the top of the window and click **Add**. Then, click **OK**.
6. Click the **Custom Level** button. Then, scroll down to the **Use Phishing Filter** setting, and select **Disable**. Then, click **OK**.
7. Close all IE browser windows, then open a new IE browser window to log on to the MLS.

Option 2: Disable the Phishing Filter for all sites

1. From a new Internet Explorer window, click **Tools > Phishing Filter > Phishing Filter Settings**.
2. Scroll down to the **Phishing Filter** setting, and click **Disable Phishing Filter**.
3. Click **OK**.
